ACLU CASE UPDATE

The ACLU has filed for summary judgment regarding the lawsuit against Oklahoma City in regards to what is commonly referred to as the panhandling ordinance.

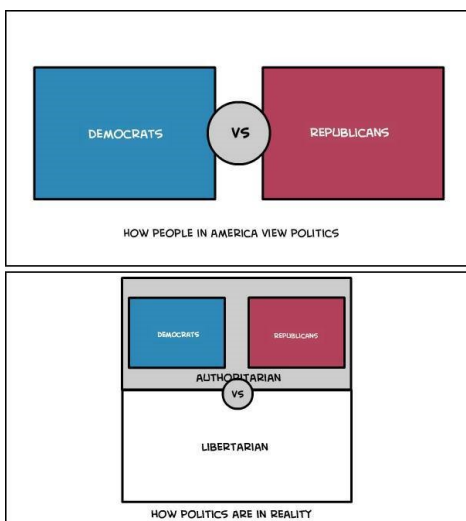


ACLU ATTORNEYS AND PLAINTIFFS April 12, 2016

Back in April of this year the OKLP joined 8 other plaintiffs in that lawsuit. Ordinance 25,283 prohibits the "sitting, standing, or staying" on city medians virtually for any purpose other than to cross them. That means among other things that no one is allowed to stand on medians within city limits to hold campaign signs, wave to passing voters on election day or rally support for political causes.

I believe this ordinance was enacted with the intention of targeting the free speech of panhandlers ...and the free speech of political activists and of every other citizen simply became collateral damage. The Libertarian Party has a saying, "All rights, for all people, all the time." We like it because it's catchy and memorable. It's also a moral standard, necessary for a moral government. "Some rights, for some people" will end in tyranny for all. Cruel and oppressive government is always instituted to control "those people." When will we learn that we are all "those people" to someone?

CHANGING THE CONVERSATION



There is a major shift happening in our country as more and more people learn the value of looking at the whole of politics through the very simple lens described in this meme.

Libertarians can facilitate the spread of this understanding by reframing issues within its context. It's a way of discussing issues that keeps everyone on the same team in opposition to overreaching state authority rather than dividing us all up and pitting us against each other.

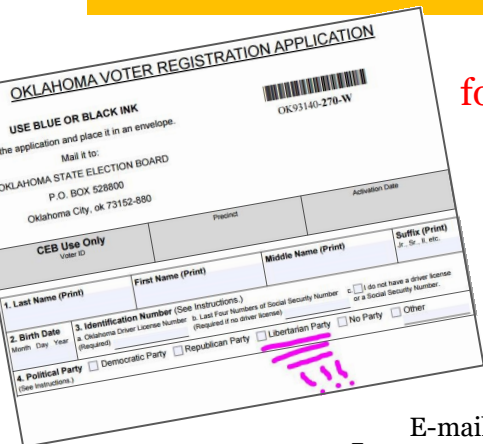

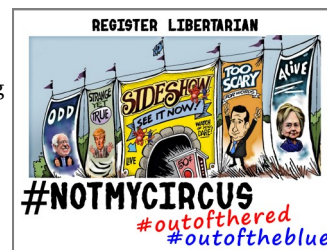
