

## Become a State Delegate

Members of the Oklahoma Libertarian Party (OKLP) have the right to participate in the official affairs and governance of the Party, including serving as delegates to the State Convention. Delegates participate by voting on internal OKLP elections for such things as State Executive Committee Officers and At Large Representatives, Judicial Committee members, Bylaws & Platform Committee members, who our delegates to the national LNC Convention will be, and proposed changes to our state party Bylaws and Platform, among other things.

To qualify as a Member of the Oklahoma Libertarian Party and delegate to the State Convention, one must<sup>1</sup>:

- Have indicated opposition to the initiation of force to achieve political or social goals;
- Be a resident of Oklahoma;
- Be a registered Libertarian<sup>2</sup>; and,
- Have paid dues which are current no later than thirty (30) days prior to the start of the State Convention or hold a Lifetime membership in the OKLP<sup>3</sup>.
