<u>Determination of Open or Closed Libertarian Primaries (SR001)</u>

Adopted at SEC 10.1.4 on 21 November 2021

Motion creating a Standing Rule, effective immediately, stating:

Oklahoma state law gives recognized parties the option to open their primaries to registered Independents by notifying the Secretary of the State Election Board between November 1 and November 30 every odd-numbered year. This decision rightfully belongs to OKLP convention delegates as it concerns our Party primaries.

During the OKLP State Convention immediately preceding such required notice -- usually in odd-numbered years -- "Open or Closed Primaries" shall be included on the convention business meeting Agenda or Schedule, allowing time for the delegates at that convention to discuss and vote on a motion directing the Chair as to what notification shall be given to the Secretary of the State Election Board concerning this matter for the upcoming election cycle.

Should the delegates fail to arrive at a majority decision during such a convention, the State Executive Committee shall, in a duly-called meeting thereafter, vote on a motion directing the Chair as to what notification shall be given to the Secretary of the State Election Board concerning the matter for the upcoming election cycle, with the outcome decided by a simple majority of the full committee including the Chair. In the event that the State Executive Committee vote is tied, the Chair shall decide the matter and notify the Secretary of the State Election Board accordingly.

Under no circumstances shall the Chair fail to act in accordance with a majority vote outlined above which decides this matter.

The motion carried with ten in favor, none opposed, and one abstention, and took effect 21 November 2021.
